**NAVAJO Sweat Lodges guessing A.D. 1860 to 1900
Mal Pais, NM over by Acoma and Grants, NM

About every 50 or 60 miles of walking and you will bump into an old Navajo sweat lodge. The doors face east, and it's a sacred or religious act these lodges served to the Dine or Navajo natives.

A typical Lodge has about 70 dry cedar posts stacked against a standing frame of one or two crook posts. They crook it first by placing two up-right anchors and the door frame is made, then the rest are piled or laid on. A hearth and a pile of cast away stones occur near the door. Some of the stones are fire cracked from the water being on them soon after pulling from the fire. A steam and a sweat.

Three linear inches of lichens grow on the busted stones and lichens is about the only way to date these unless artifacts of cans, tobacco tins, or glass occur...
