

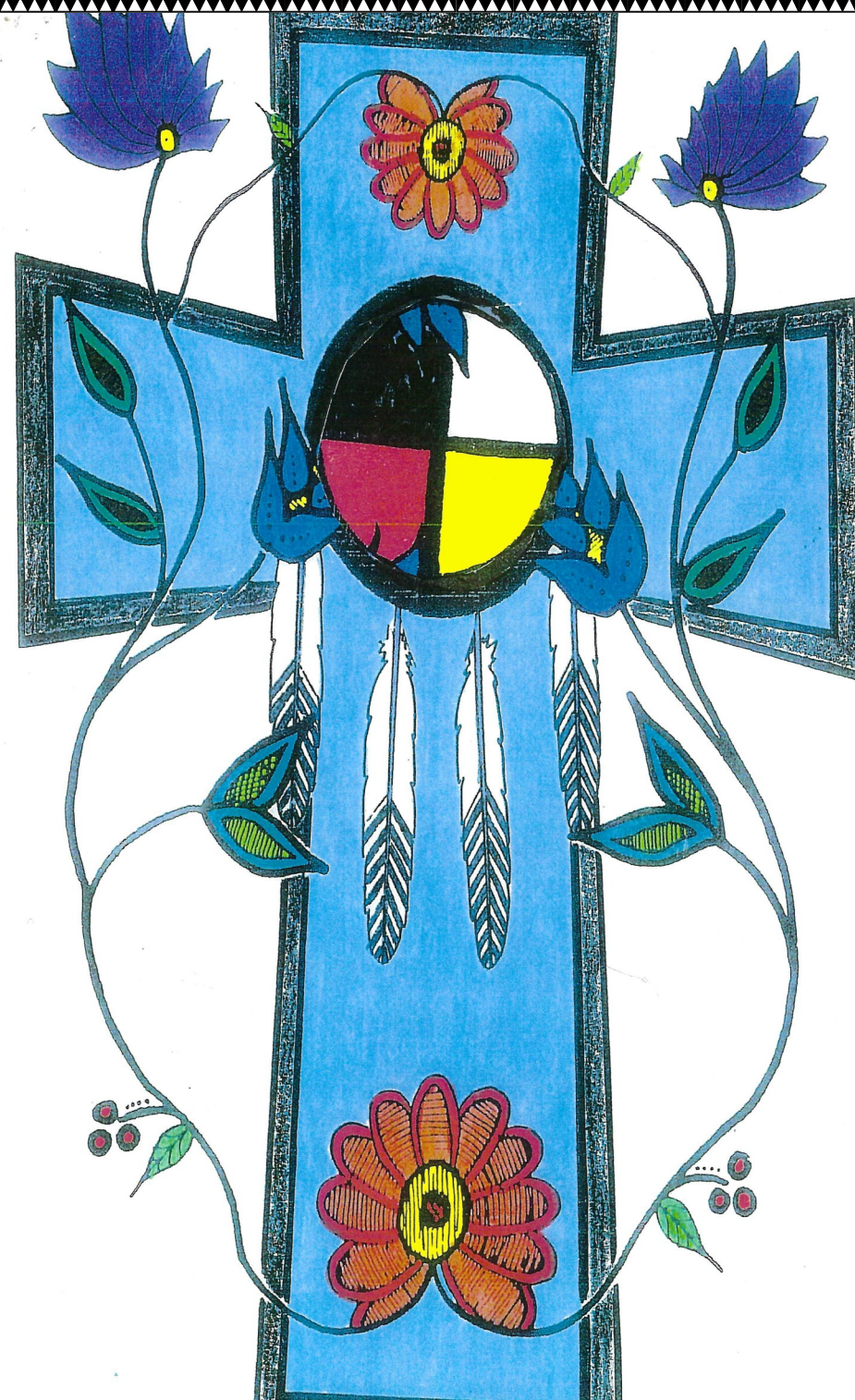

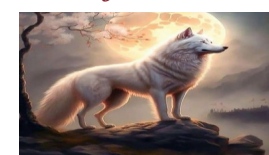


Prayer Group Meeting
